| 2019-20 | AB 2054 | Kamlager | Community Emergency Response | Program to support alternatives to law enforcement response to crises in community. |
| 2019-20 | AB 2200/2542 | Kalra | Racial Justice Act | Prohibits discrimination in sentencing and convictions. |
| 2019-20 | AB 2512 | Stone | Intellectual Disability | Modernizes laws preventing intellectually disabled individuals from receiving the death penalty. |
| 2019-20 | SCR 69 | Bradford | Fair Prisoner Wages | Expresses support for fair wages for incarcerated workers. |
| 2019-20 | SB 144 | Mitchell | Fines and Fees | Repeals burdensome criminal justice fines and fees. |
| 2019-20 | AB 3099 | Ramos | Crimes Native American Communities | Promotes cooperation amongst law enforcement agencies addressing crimes in and near native communities. |
| 2019-20 | AB 901 | Gipson | Voluntary juvenile probation | Would limit the use of voluntary juvenile probation. |
| 2019-20 | AB 927 | Jones-Sawyer | Fines and Fees: ability to pay | Would require that individuals have the ability to repay criminal justice fine and fees levied against them. |
| 2019-20 | SB 36 | Hertzberg, Mitchell | Pretrial release: risk assessment tools | Provides guidelines for the use and evaluation of pre-trial risk assessment tools |
| 2019-20 | SB 136 | Weiner | Sentencing: enhancement repeal | Repeals the automatic one-year sentence enhancement for each prior felony. |
| 2019-20 | SB 310 | Skinner | Ex-felon jury eligibility | Allows those with a prior felony conviction who've completed their sentence to serve on a jury, unless convicted of a registrable sex-crime. |
| 2019-20 | Budget Ask | N/A | Criminal Justice -- bail, BSCC | The Budget includes total funding of \$4.1 billion (\$2.1 billion General Fund and \$2.0 billion other funds) in 2019-20 for the Judicial Branch, of which \$2.4 billion is provided to support trial court operations. |
| 2019-20 | Budget Ask | N/A | Implementing Criminal Justice Reforms | Funding for local public defender office's in support of recently passed CJ reforms. |
| 2017-18 | SB 620 | Bradford | Gun sentence enhancement reform | Given judicial discretion to strike or dismiss gun sentence enhancements. |
| 2017-18 | SB 180 | Mitchell | Repeal Ineffective Sentence Enhancements Act | Repeals 3-year enhancement for prior drug convictions. |
| 2017-18 | SB 54 | DeLeon | California Values Act | Limits state and local involvement in immigration enforcement. |
| 2017-18 | AB 90 | Weber | Criminal Gangs | Increased accuracy, fairness and transparency of CalGang database information. |
| 2017-18 | SB 10 | Hertzberg | Pre-trial Services/Bail Reform | Eliminate cash bail in California. |
| 2017-18 | SB 1393 | Mitchell | Sentencing enhancement reform | Would restore judicial discretion in applying 5-year sentence enhancement for prior serious felony conviction. |
| 2017-18 | AB 2944 | Jones-Sawyer | Schools Not Prisons Voluntary Tax Contribution Fund | Allow tax filers to contribute to a fund supporting efforts to end school to prison pipeline. |
